Lake History

The Lake was named after an incident in 1871, where a group of inmates escaped from prison in Carson City, NV. A posse, led by Sheriff George Hightower eventually caught up with the convicts and a shootout took place, ultimately giving Convict Lake its name. Mount Morrison and Mono Jim peaks were also named after posse members who were killed in the encounter.
